**Information regarding the Year 6 Fanwood Residential**

**2<sup>nd</sup> , 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> October 2024**

**Transport:** Please ensure that your child arrives at school on time - we will be setting off by coach at approximately 09:15. Please use the front entrance and escort children and luggage to the Year 6 classroom. Children do not need to wear school uniform and should arrive in clothing suitable for outdoor activities (please see kit list herewith).

***\*Children will need to bring a packed lunch on Wednesday. Please inform us if you would like a school packed lunch\****

**Accommodation:** Children will be allocated a bedroom before arrival. Toilets are adjacent to bedrooms and there are a number of bathrooms on site, including an accessible shower/WC. Friendship groups will be taken into consideration when allocating bedrooms.

**Valuables:** Children should **not** bring mobile phones, i-pads, tablets, smart watches, music players or any electronic devices. School will not accept responsibility for lost or damaged equipment. Children are encouraged to bring a book, magazine or puzzle/colouring book.

**Medication:** If your child has any medical needs please indicate this clearly on the form that has been provided. Russell Hall staff will only be able to administer medication (including travel sickness tablets) if the appropriate consent form has been completed - please collect these from the school office.

**Behaviour:** Children will be made aware of expectations regarding behavior prior to the residential. Whilst we want your child to have fun, we cannot allow any dangerous or unsafe behavior. Some of the planned activities involve using equipment that must be handled sensibly. If your child is deemed to display unsafe or challenging behavior you will be asked to collect your child and they will not be able to take part in the remainder of the trip.

Children can be collected from school at the usual time. If we are going to be late due to transport issues you will be notified by the school office via text.

## Equipment List

We suggest that your child brings the following items:

- A large towel
- Toilet bag containing: Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hairbrush, etc
- Pyjamas/nightwear
- Socks and underwear
- Fleece, sweatshirt or jumper
- Shorts, t-shirts, sunhat
- Sun cream
- Trousers/tracksuit bottoms/joggers
- Waterproof jacket or coat
- Change of clothes for indoor activities
- Appropriate footwear for outdoor activities
  
- Water bottle
- Packed lunch (for Wednesday)
- Sweets and treats (at your discretion)
  
- 1 x pair of indoor shoes or slippers
- 1 x large plastic bag for dirty clothes
- **Sleeping bag or quilt, bed sheet and pillow**
- Any medication (including a completed medical consent form)

*All the above items should be packed into a small travel bag.*

We strongly advise you **NOT** to bring any of the following.

- Valuables, watches, jewellery
- Money - there is no shop and all food is provided
- Hairdryers - these are provided in all rooms
- Mobile phones, i-pads, smart watches, electronic devices
