

Literacy (L)

Joins in with familiar rhymes and stories

Singing Nursery Rhymes Hears and uses new vocabulary from stories, rhymes, poems and non-fiction books Story times/topic learning

Sequences stories/ events (not always in order)

Identifies characters/ settings/ events in stories

Use words and/or gestures

Making Christmas cards

Writing to Santa

Mark making using mark makers such as chunky chalks, paintbrushes, pens

Following large pattern templates

Draw some marks on paper, not always distinguishable

Physical Development (PD)

Squiggle whilst you wiggle

Zipping up a coat

Chalking

Dough disco

·Hand washing/hygiene

Moving freely jumping on and off objects over and through balancing and climbing equipment

Communication and Language (CL)

Listen to others
Ask questions
Begin to distinguish sounds
Begin to oral blend words
Joining in with repeated refrains in rhymes and stories
(nursery rhyme week)
